Free Agent Youth Soccer Program Information For Parents

Frequently asked questions:

What is a free agent? Free agents are individual players that we place on teams.

What does the U stand for? The U stands for “under”. For example: U6 includes kids that are 5 years old or younger as of August 1st of the current year. (They can turn 6 on August 2nd and still play U6) Although we use these age groups to begin each session, we may move kids to other age groups based on our assessment. This assessment takes into account the physical, social and cognitive levels of each player and group.

What is the MAC Soccer Maintenance fee used for? This fee will be used to help maintain the indoor fields, make purchases, repairs and support administrative costs.

How do I register my child? This can be done on-line, in person or by mail. Fill out the MAC Soccer Maintenance/Wavier along with a registration form (both available on our web site or at the MAC). There is a registration fee for each session, and the MSM fee is due every August 1st.

Can we request to be with a friend? We will try to put your player with another player if requested, however we make no guarantee. Requests should be made via e-mail to aboath@soccermac.com.

When do we play games? Youth free agents practice one evening a week and play a game on Saturday or Sunday. Your practice day should remain the same but the game day and times will vary. **BE SURE TO CHECK THE WEBSITE WEEKLY FOR POSSIBLE CHANGES IN THE SCHEDULES.**

How do I know what team my child has been placed on? Sometimes we don't know until very close to the start of a session exactly which kids will play on which teams. We will post the roster at soccermac.com as soon as possible, or you can call or e-mail us to check.

Why would I be asked to change my requested time or day? We cannot always predict the number of players we will have for each session. We will add or delete practice times based on the number of teams we have for each session and we may need to ask some players to switch days in order to keep a good ratio of players per team.

What should my child wear and bring? Shorts, t-shirt (MAC issued game shirt), athletic shoes, shin guards and of course a water bottle. Soccer shoes with plastic cleats can also be worn but are not required.

How do I know when games are scheduled? Check the soccermac.com web site often. Each team will be named and a roster for each team will be posted on line as soon as possible. However, the roster can change with the number of players we have.

What if we can't make a practice or game? Please let your coach know or you can send us a quick e-mail.

Why are there times when we have a different coach? All our MAC coaches are qualified to coach these teams. If a coach has a scheduling conflict, we don't reschedule all the kids, we have one of our other coaches help out.

Do I have to participate in fund raising or pay a “buy out” fee? No, you do not have any fund raising responsibilities when you play as a free agent at the MAC.
